- 1994 Major construction and shaping completed in June, planting of the Champion course greens, fairways commences. July academy course opened to the public for play.  
November 18th. Grand Opening of the Golf Course, with Gala Dinner at Altis Hotel.
- 1995 The first big event at the National the Mercedes Benz Cup. David Feherty, David Jones, David Kearney & Andy Stubbs play an entertaining exhibition match.
- 1996 The first ever Professional Golf Tournament to be hosted in Turkey  
The European Seniors Tour Beko/ Oger Tours Turkish Open won by South African Bobby Verwey.
- 1997 The second European Seniors Tour event. The Beko Seniors Turkish Open. Won by England's Tommy Horton.

A good drive down the right side of the fairway sets you up for a second shot down a narrow fairway, leaving a short iron approach to a large undulating green.

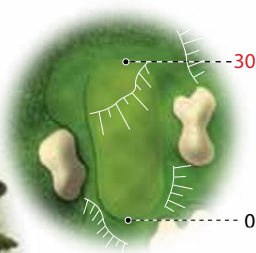

This slight dog-leg right hole requires a solid drive down the left side of the fairway, leaving you with a well sighted mid iron approach to this small and well protected green.

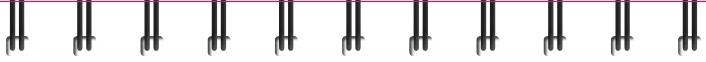

A dog-leg left with a blind tee shot makes the line off the tee all-important. Often a long iron or fairway wood is used. An ideal drive is slightly left of the big pine tree in the middle of the fairway. This is a real makers hole and requires a well struck short iron to hold on this small elevated green.

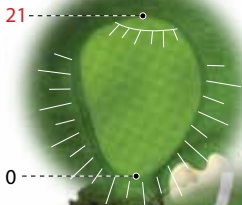

Accuracy off the tee is key here, favour the right hand side of the fairway taking aim at the right of the 2 bunkers to leave a short iron that opens up the green. Take aim at the centre of the green, take your par and run!

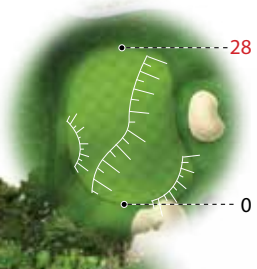

Be careful to avoid the bunkers short left of the green particularly if you draw the ball. Another hole where par feels like a birdie. This green feeds from the right hand side.

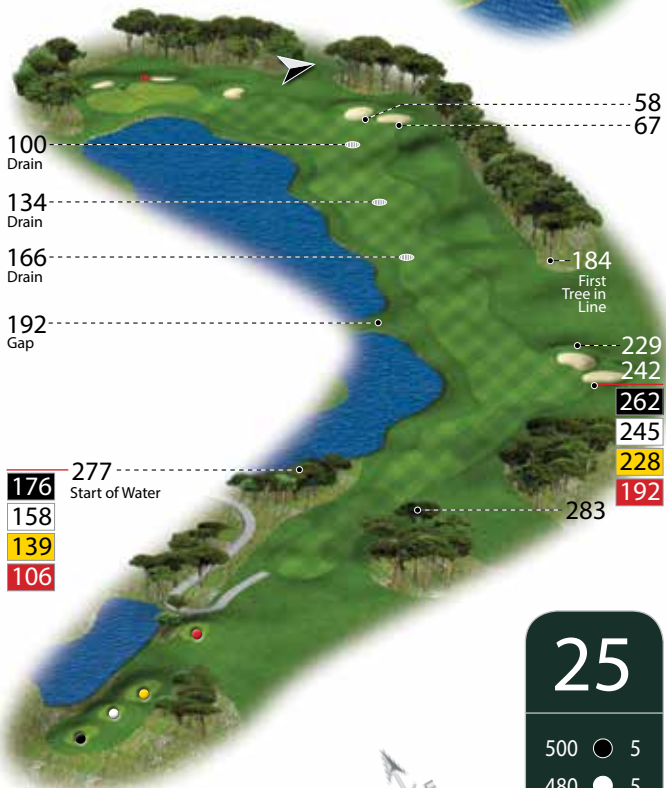
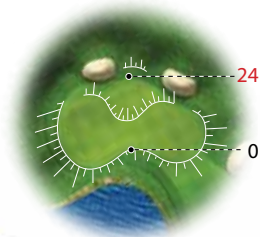

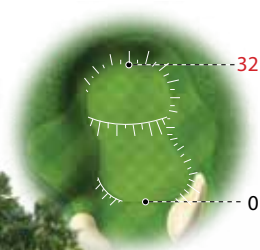
